Years of repeated erosion and divot repairs from clinic and park visitors, large trucks (FedEx, UPS, Amazon, etc.) plus our garbage truck, now require a change. We want to fix this permanently!

After receiving bids to create a concrete pad entrance to withstand the heavy traffic, we are seeking your assistance to cover the cost of \$21,600.

Increasing the entering and exiting safety for everyone is primary. This is of the utmost importance to all of us at Animal Friends.
